PETITION FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF NXX-X CODE DENIAL

Teleport Communications America, LLC - FL (TCAL) pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(iv), Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) Order FCC 00-104, and Florida Public Service Commission (“Commission”) Order No. PSC-01-1873-PCO-TL, petitions the Commission to review the Pooling Administrator’s (“NeuStar”) denial of AT&T’s request for additional numbering resources in the Port Charlotte rate center. In support of this petition, AT&T states:

PARTIES

1. AT&T is a corporation organized and formed under the laws of the State of New Jersey.
2. NeuStar is an independent non-governmental entity, which is responsible for administering and managing the numbering resources in pooling areas. See 47 C.F.R. § 52.20(d).

JURISDICTION

3. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Industry Numbering Committees (INC) Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c). This provision provides that a carrier may challenge NeuStar’s decision to deny numbering resources to the appropriate regulatory authority.

BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF

4. The Port Charlotte rate center consists of 1 switching entity, FTMYFLXAX1Z. There are ~480 numbers working and ~520 numbers available in 941-249-6.

5. On January 22, 2018, AT&T requested 4000 consecutive numbers from NeuStar, for the Port Charlotte rate center, to satisfy the customer's request.

6. At the time of the request, the Port Charlotte rate center had a MTE of 4.91 months and utilization of ~48.1%.

7. January 22, 2018, NeuStar denied AT&T's request because AT&T had not met the utilization criteria, notwithstanding the fact that AT&T is unable to provide the numbering resources requested by the specific customer. See Attachment 1. Pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, attached to this Petition is the customer contact information. See Attachment 2.

8. As discussed above, both the FCC Order and the INC guidelines provide that state regulatory authorities have the power and authority to review NeuStar's decision to deny a request for numbering resources. See INC Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c).

9. Under earlier MTE procedures used by NANPA, waivers or exceptions were granted when customer hardships could be demonstrated or when the service provider's inventory did not have the specific number format to meet the customer's specific request. The current process is arbitrary and results in (1) decisions contrary to the public interest and welfare of consumers in Florida; and (2) decisions that do not necessarily promote the efficient use of telephone numbers.

10. AT&T requests that the Commission's reverse NeuStar's decision to withhold numbering resources on the following grounds:

(a) NeuStar's denial of numbering resources to AT&T interferes with AT&T's ability to serve its customer in Florida.

(b) As a result of NeuStar's denial of the request for additional numbering resources, AT&T is unable to provide telecommunications services to its customer as required under Florida law.

WHEREFORE, AT&T requests:

1. The Commission review the decision of NeuStar to deny AT&T's request for additional numbering resources for the Port Charlotte rate center; and

2. The Commission direct NeuStar to provide the requested numbering resources for the Port Charlotte rate center as discussed above.
