On January 8, 2018, Florida City Gas (FCG) filed a request for confidential classification for certain information provided in Document No. 00189-2018. This document contains FCG responses to the Office of Public Counsel (OPC) sixth set of interrogatories and sixth set of production of documents (POD) in the subject docket. The information for which FCG seeks confidential treatment is contained in interrogatory response No. 157a and in POD responses Nos. 105, 108, 109, 118, and 120.

The response to interrogatory No. 157a contains business customer names, annual term usage for each customer, and the year the customer inquired about potential service.

The response to POD No. 105 contains information sent by FCG to individual Third Party Marketers with cost of capacity released; POD 108 contains information with respect to customers that have converted from sales service to third party service listing the name of each business customer and the marketer chosen; POD 109 contains a list of customers that have converted to sales service from previous third party marketer service listing the business name of each customer, name of marketer, and rate schedule; POD 118 contains a list of large transportation customers, the winter DCQ associated with each customer, and a designation of essential or non-essential use transportation customer; and POD 120 contains information related to the emergence of the Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) market. Staff has reviewed the information and concurs with FGT that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections. 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes (F.S.).
