This recommendation addresses the request for confidential classification for certain information contained in responses to Citizens' revised 1st requests for production of documents (POD), No. 29, provided in Document No. 10137-2017 by Florida City Gas (FCG), pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

Staff has reviewed FCG's responses to Citizens' revised 1st requests for POD No. 29 regarding FCG's assessment of gas supply options in South Florida, which contain proprietary confidential business information and information relating to competitive interests. Disclosure of such information could impair the competitive business of the provider of information or the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. In staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that FCG's request for confidential classification be approved.
