Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc., and Shady Hills Energy Center, LLC. (Petitioners), request confidential classification of certain portions of Hearing Exhibit Nos. 102, 103, and 116, proffered by Quantum Pasco Power, L.P., Michael Tulk, and Patrick Daly (Intervenors), at the Hearing that concluded on March 22, 2018.

Petitioners request confidentiality of the highlighted sections of these Hearing Exhibits under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S.: "Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.: "Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

The highlighted information in Exhibit Nos. 102 & 103 can be described as information related to bids provided to Seminole in response to its requests for proposals for power supply, a natural gas supply lateral, and a long-term service agreement for the Seminole Combined Cycle Facility, in addition to Seminole's wholesale pricing data. The highlighted information in Exhibit No. 116 can be described as financial statements that include projected revenue and cost information, as well as, information related to Seminole's outstanding debt obligations. Staff has reviewed the information that Petitioners have filed, as well as their confidentiality request, and believes the information that is the subject of the request meets the criteria for confidentiality under the sections requested.
