TO CUSTOMERS OF LAKESIDE WATERWORKS, INC.

DATED: DECEMBER 6, 2017

By Order No. PSC-2017-0428-PAA-WS, in Docket No. 20160195-WS, issued November 7, 2017, the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved an increase in water and wastewater rates and added a Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) charge for Lakeside Waterworks, Inc. (utility). A schedule of Commission approved rates and charges are set forth below.

Approved Non-Sufficient Funds Charge (NSF)

Pursuant to Section 68.065, Florida Statutes the following NSF charges may be assessed:

- 1) \$25, if the face value does not exceed \$50
- 2) \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300
- 3) \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300,
- 4) or five percent of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater

The rates shall be effective for service rendered as of the Commission's stamped approval date on the tariff sheets provided the customers have received notice. If the effective date of the new rates falls within a regular billing cycle, the initial bills at the new rate may be prorated. The old charges shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle before the effective date of the new rates. The new charges shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle on or after the effective date of the new rates.
