The purpose of this hearing shall be to receive testimony and exhibits relative to incremental storm restoration costs related to Hurricane Matthew, the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement dated May 14, 2018, and to take action on any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement. This proceeding shall: (1) allow the parties to present evidence and testimony in support of their positions; and (2) allow for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate.

<u>PUBLIC TESTIMONY</u>: Any member of the public who wishes to offer testimony should be present at the beginning of the hearing on June 5, 2018. By providing public testimony, a person does not become a party to the proceeding. To become an official party of record, you must file a Petition for Intervention at least 20 days before the final hearing, pursuant to the requirements contained in Rule 25-106.205, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony. The proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Chapters 120 and 366, Florida Statutes; and Chapters 28-106 and 25-22, F.A.C.
