Rule 25-14.014, F.A.C., Accounting for Asset Retirement Obligations Under SFAS 143 would codify how regulated utilities treat the legal obligations associated with the retirement of tangible, long-lived assets under the Financial Accounting Standard Board (FSAB) Statement No. 143 (SFAS 143). Some separate subaccounts would be required and the application of SFAS 143 would have to be revenue neutral in the rate making process.

The Florida Administrative Procedures Act encourages an agency to prepare a Statement of Estimated Regulatory Costs (SERC). However, regulated corporations must comply with the statements of the FASB under regulation of the Securities and Exchange Commission and should have only minor costs complying with the proposed rule. Therefore, a SERC will not be prepared for the proposed rule.
