Dear Mr. Gomez:

Thank you for your letter in which you expressed concerns regarding the proposed rates included in the preliminary staff report and discussed at the June 20, 2018 customer meeting for the River Ranch Water Management, L.L.C. (River Ranch) staff-assisted rate (SARC). To ensure that the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) staff and Commissioners have knowledge of your concerns, your letter has been placed in the correspondence section of the docket file.

Pursuant to Section 367.081, Florida Statutes, the Commission must allow each utility under its jurisdiction the opportunity to earn a fair return on its investment. In addition, the Commission is required to set rates that are just, reasonable, compensatory, and not unfairly discriminatory. Staff's proposed rates were designed to reflect the estimated demand for each customer group. However, as a result of staff's site visit, investigation, and customer input, staff discovered that several properties within the service area were not metered and the metered data that was available was not reliable for purposes of estimating customer demand. Therefore, staff is reviewing other methods of estimating demand for purposes of setting final rates.
