3. Referring to page 4 of the petition, please explain why the GRIP Factor for Rate Class FTS-10 decreased from last year while all other classes increased.

#### **Company Response:**

The total revenue requirement, including estimated true-up, increased from \$3.5M to \$4.2M. Therefore increasing the GRIP factor per therm for all rate classes except FTS-10. This is attributed to two factors, allocations and projected therms per rate class. The allocations are based on a cost of service study from the last rate case. As can be seen on schedule D-1 of the file provided in question two above, the allocation factors for FTS-10 are relatively lower than other large volume rate classes. Due to the revenue requirement increase, the allocated amount to be recovered in FTS-10 did increase from \$221K (2018) to \$262K (2019), however, the corresponding increase in projected therms ultimately caused the decrease in the GRIP factor. The increase in projected therms in FTS-10 is due to an additional customer previously in FTS-9.
