By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) provide responses to the following data requests:

If FPL has updated anticipated retirement dates for the Martin and Lauderdale Units, please provide an updated estimate of the unamortized balances that FPL is seeking to include in the regulatory asset.
- 2.) In Docket No. 20170123-EI, FPL agreed to commence amortization of the costs associated with the St. Johns River Power Park (SJRPP) during the term of its current settlement agreement. Please identify within the Settlement Agreement, the language that permits FPL to defer amortizing the regulatory assets associated with the early retirement of Martin Units 1 and 2 and Lauderdale Units 4 and 5.
- 3.) For all accounts shown on Attachment KF-1 of FPL's petition, please list the 2017 actual depreciation expense. Please separate between Capital Recovery Accounts Base and Capital Recovery Accounts Clause.
