Dear Ms. Stauffer:

On October 15, 2018, AT&T Florida advised the Commission and parties that pursuant to Section 4.5.2 of its Self Effectuating Enforcement Mechanisms Administration Plan ("SEEM Plan"), AT&T Florida declared a force majeure event in connection with Hurricane Michael that began on October 9, 2018. The measures affected as a result of the force majeure event include all measures associated with Provisioning, Maintenance & Repair, and Trunk Group Performance.

As set forth below, AT&T Florida lifts its remaining force majeure declaration associated with Provisioning, Maintenance & Repair, and Trunk Group performance in 9 of the 10 wire centers designated in its October 15, 2018 filing.
