DISCUSSION ABOUT WATER USAGE IN CAMP FLORIDA

Some facts:

There are 397 sites in Camp Florida, not counting common ground water 1 usage. Meaning the Pool, Pool House, Club House, 7 Bath-washer Houses and two or three additional sites are covered under another account.

2 There are 4764 billing months for water-397 times 12=4764.

There are 28 full time units, that is, 28 units using water 12 months per 3 year. This means that there are 336 billing months being used 12 months of the year-28 times 12=336.

Taking into consideration that the balance of the units are occupied for 3 4 months, 4 months or 5 months, we will use 4 months as our base line. Therefore, there are 369 sites used for 4 months-369 times 4=1476 billing months of water used.

Combining months of water usage, we have 336 plus 1476=1812 months of 5 water usage.

Subtracting 1812 of water usage from 4764 months of water usage total 6 available, we have 2952 months billed with no water or sewer being used. This means that roughly 62 percent of the time, there is no water or sewer being used.

7 Using the Ridley household as an example, our bill with no usage is 25 dollars per month in 2018. Using 25 dollars as a base line, the Water Company acquires approx. 73780 dollars for nothing.

Many complain that the water is undrinkable and I know many people filter 8 their water prior to drinking.
