The current issue of the Florida Administrative Weekly includes a Notice of Proposed Rule Development concerning rule 25-22.036, stating that the Public Service Commission intends to repeal subsection (3) of the rule. See 26 Fla. Admin. Weekly 1723-24 (April 14, 2000). The notice states that if timely requested and not deemed unnecessary by the Commission, a rule development workshop will be held at 9:30 a.m. on May 2.

As you know, our client, Florida Power & Light Company (FP&L), challenged rule 25-22.036(3) at the Division of Administrative Hearings. The rule challenge is now on appeal at the First District Court of Appeal. <u>See Florida Power & Light Company v. Public Service</u> <u>Commission</u>, Case No. 1D99-4552. All briefs have been filed in the case, and a request for oral argument is pending.

Given the rule challenge and pending appellate proceedings, FP&L has a significant interest in rule 25-22.036(3) and in the staff's reasons for proposing its repeal. FP&L, through this letter, requests that the rule development workshop be held on May 2, 2000, so that issues relating to the proposed repeal can be discussed.
