Pursuant to Section 366.093, (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information filed in response to a staff document request, in the above referenced docket, dated 6/18/19. This recommendation specifically addresses DEF's response to Staff's 2nd Production of Documents (PODs) request, Nos. 3-5.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its response to Staff's 2nd PODs, Nos. 3-4, under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S., and No. 5 under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Subsection (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

The information provided in response to Staff's 2nd PODs, for which confidential treatment is being sought can be described as specific economic-related data (Nos. 3 and 4), and projected long-term natural gas and coal (commodity) fuel price forecasts (No. 5), all of which were obtained from third-party providers.

Staff has reviewed the documents DEF filed in response to Staff's 2nd PODs, Nos. 3-5, as well as the Company's confidentiality request. It is staff's opinion that the information subject to this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S., and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
