Per the Statute, proprietary confidential business information includes, but is not limited to; Subsection (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Subsection (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information." The information provided in response to staff's second set of interrogatories for which confidential treatment is being sought can be described as projected component installed costs and estimated annual land lease cost for the solar projects. The information provided in response to staff's third production of documents No. 6 for which confidential treatment is being sought can be described as terms of the lease regarding costs to the Company.
