Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) requests confidential classification of certain information filed in response to a staff data request, in the above referenced docket, dated July 25, 2019. This recommendation specifically addresses the two highlighted amounts included in FPUC's response to Staff's First Data Request, No. 4.

FPUC is claiming confidentiality of yellow highlighted information and information printed on yellow stock paper in its response to Staff's First Data Request, No. 4, under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety or confidential business information includes, but is not limited to; Subsection (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms."

The information provided in response to Staff's First Data Request, No. 4, for which confidential treatment is being sought, can be described as payment amounts made to third parties for assistance with the 2020 FEECA Goalsetting process.

Staff has reviewed the information FPUC filed in response to Staff's First Data Request, No. 4, as well as the Company's confidentiality request. It is staff's opinion that the information that is the subject of this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S., as applies to the highlighted information in response to Staff's First Data Request, No. 4.
