REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

GULF POWER COMPANY ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or the "Company"], by and through its undersigned attorney and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files a request that the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order protecting from public disclosure certain portions of Gulf Power's Hedging Activity Report. As grounds for this request, the Company states:

- 1. Pursuant to the Order Establishing Procedure in this docket, Order No. PSC-2019-0059-PCO-EI, Gulf Power is required to file a Hedging Activity Report by August 9, 2019 detailing its hedging transactions during the months of January through July of the current year.
- 2. A portion of the information in the Hedging Activity Report constitutes proprietary and commercially sensitive information regarding competitive interests and contractual matters of Gulf Power which, if disclosed to the general public, would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power and its customers. This information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes. Specifically, the information consists of pricing terms for natural gas hedging transactions between Gulf Power and various counterparties. Gulf, its counterparties and other members of the market in which it competes consider this type of information to be competitively sensitive. Disclosure of this information would adversely affect Gulf's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms for the benefit of its customers, would impair the competitive interests of Gulf and its vendors, and would place Gulf at a competitive disadvantage when coupled with other information that is publicly available.

- The information filed pursuant to this Request is intended to be, and is treated as, confidential by Gulf Power and, to this attorney's knowledge, has not been otherwise publicly disclosed.
- 4. Submitted as Exhibit "A" is a copy of Gulf Power's Hedging Activity Report, on which is highlighted the information for which confidential classification is requested. Exhibit "A" should be treated as confidential pending a ruling on this request. Attached as Exhibit "B" are two (2) edited copies of Gulf's Hedging Activity Report which may be made available for public review and inspection. Attached as Exhibit "C" to this request is a line-by-line/field-by-field justification for the request for confidential classification.

WHEREFORE, Gulf Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order protecting the information highlighted on Exhibit "A" from public disclosure as proprietary confidential business information.
