## PETITION OF MCIMETRO ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES LLC D/B/A VERIZON TRANSMISSION SERVICES LLC FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF SOMOS' DENIAL OF APPLICATION FOR NUMBERING RESOURCES

MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Transmission Services LLC (Verizon) requests that the Commission review SOMOS' denial of Verizon's application for a one Thousand Block of telephone numbers (Thousand Block) in the Clearwater, Florida rate center, overturn that decision, and order that a Thousand Block be assigned to Verizon. In support of this Petition, Verizon states:

#### **PARTIES**

- 1. Verizon is a competitive local exchange telecommunications company that provides local exchange service and exchange access service in Florida.
- 2. SOMOS is an independent non-governmental entity that is responsible for administering and managing the numbering resources in pooling areas. See 47 C.F.R. § 52.20(d).

#### **JURISDICTION**

3. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter under Section 364.16(7), Florida Statutes.

#### **BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF**

- 4. A large business customer that uses a direct inward (DID) arrangement has requested that Verizon provide 300 consecutive DID telephone numbers in the 727 NPA in the Clearwater FL rate center so the customer can meet its dial plan arrangements. A confidential copy of the customer's letter explaining the circumstances is attached as Confidential Exhibit 1.
- 5. Because Verizon does not have 300 consecutive telephone numbers in its inventory, it applied on August 9, 2019 to the Pooling Administrator, SOMOS, for a Thousand Block in the Clearwater, Florida rate center. Verizon's application is attached as Exhibit 2.
- 6. SOMOS denied Verizon's request on August 9, 2019. The request was denied because Verizon did not meet the FCC criteria that SOMOS applies, even though Verizon does not have the numbering resources needed to satisfy its customer's request. Verizon's utilization did not meet the FCC's 75% threshold, or the six months-to-exhaust calculation. The Months-to-Exhaust and Utilization Worksheet is attached as Confidential Exhibit 3. SOMOS' denial of Verizon's application is attached as Exhibit 4.
- 7. The FCC has delegated authority to the Commission to address SOMOS' denial of a request for numbering resources, stating that "[w]e agree ... that a safety valve mechanism should be established, and we delegate authority to state commissions to hear claims that a safety valve should be applied when the .... Pooling Administrator denies a specific request for numbering

resources."<sup>1</sup> Moreover, the FCC has determined that "a carrier should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy a specific customer request." Specifically, states "may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers."<sup>2</sup>

- 8. Based on this authority, the Commission has issued a number of orders addressing denials by SOMOS' that release numbering resources to meet specific customer needs. For example, the Commission ordered NeuStar to provide CenturyLink with numbering resources to meet the service requirements of a customer that requested 5,000 consecutive numbers, even though CenturyLink had been unable to satisfy the months-to-exhaust or utilization criteria.<sup>3</sup>
- 9. SOMOS' denial of sufficient numbering resources to Verizon to meet its customer's request is inconsistent with the FCC's position that "[u]nder no circumstances should consumers be precluded from receiving telecommunications services of their choice from providers of their choice for want of numbering resources." By refusing to grant numbering resources sufficient to meet the needs of Verizon's customer, SOMOS is preventing this customer from obtaining the service it wants from the carrier of its choice.

10. Verizon's request for a Thousand Block to meet its customer's request fits squarely within the framework established by the FCC for "safety valve" requests that the Commission is authorized to grant. Verizon respectfully requests that the Commission direct SOMOS to assign a Thousand Block for the Clearwater, Florida rate center so that Verizon can satisfy its customer's request.

WHEREFORE, Verizon respectfully requests that the Commission review SOMOS' decision to deny Verizon's request for additional numbering resources, overturn that decision, and direct SOMOS to assign Verizon a Thousand Block in the Clearwater, Florida rate center.
