**PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM'S
PRELIMINARY LIST OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS**

Peoples Gas System ("PGS"), by its undersigned attorneys, submits the following Preliminary List of Issues and Positions:

Generic Purchased Gas Adjustment Issues

ISSUE 1: What are the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2018 through December 2018?

PGS: \$4,678,361 under-recovery

ISSUE 2: What are the appropriate purchased gas adjustment actual/estimated true-up amounts for the period January 2019 through December 2019?

PGS: \$6,444,261 over-recovery

ISSUE 3: What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be refunded during the period January 2020 through December 2020?

PGS: \$1,765,900 over-recovery

ISSUE 4: What are the levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2020 through December 2020?

PGS: \$.9909 per therm

ISSUE 5: What should the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes be?

PGS: The charge should be effective beginning with the specified purchased gas cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2020 through December 2020. Billing cycles may start before January 1,

2020, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2020, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment charge became effective.

ISSUE 6: **Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the new purchased gas adjustment charges determined to be appropriate in this proceeding?**

PGS: Yes. The Commission should approve revised tariffs reflecting the purchased gas adjustment charges determined to be appropriate in this proceeding.
