On August 30, 2019, Florida Power & Light Company (“FPL”) filed its final Routine Storm Charge True-Up (“Final True-up”) in this docket. FPL’s collection of charges for the period February 1, 2019 through July 31, 2019, resulted in an over-collection of Storm-Recovery Charges and Tax Charges of \$6,278,065 and \$5,605,641, respectively. Starting on November 1, 2019, in accordance with the Final True-up, FPL credited the over-collection of Storm-Bond Recovery Charges to customers as a one-time credit in the same manner that they were collected, and FPL credited the over-collection of Tax Charges to FPL’s Storm Reserve as provided by the Financing Order. The total amount refunded to customer as part of the one-time refund related to the Storm-Bond Recovery Charges was \$6,734,282 which represents an over refund amount of \$456,216. Pursuant to the Financing Order, FPL applied the net over refund amount as a reduction to FPL’s Storm Reserve.
