RESOLUTION NO 16 - 095

(Rate Resolution amending Resolution 07-137 & Resolution 10-107)

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A POTABLE WATER SURCHARGE TO FUND WATER PROJECTS TO INCLUDE ALTERNATIVE WATER SUPPLY PROJECTS AND UTILITY SYSTEM INTERCONNECTION INITIATIVES, AND INDEXING POTABLE WATER RATES DURING A THREE YEAR PERIOD TO PAY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH WATER PRODUCTION FACILITIES REGIONALIZATION INITIATIVES AND A UTILITIES SYSTEM REINVESTMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, Polk County (the "County"), a political subdivision of the State of Florida, is authorized to establish and modify water, wastewater, and reclaimed water rates, connection fees, service charges, and customer deposits for its utility customers; and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2007, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 07-137 establishing rates for water, wastewater and reclaimed water services, fees and charges, and for customer deposits, all as set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 10-107 amending certain service rates as more particularly set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the state water management districts responsible for protecting and maintaining water and related natural resources within Polk County have indicated that future water supplies within the Central Florida area will have to come from alternative water supply sources (each and all, an "AWS") rather than the Upper Floridan Aquifer which has traditionally been the source for water supply in the area; and

WHEREAS, the County has established the Water Cooperative of Central Florida with the City of St. Cloud, Tohopekaliga Water Authority, and Orange County, and the Polk Regional Water Cooperative with most of the municipalities within the geographic boundary of Polk County, to collaboratively address future water supplies within Central Florida through the development of a wide variety of water projects and initiatives (each, whether developed by or through a cooperative or solely by the County, a "Water Project") as generally described within the interlocal agreements creating each cooperative, to include AWS projects and the development of interconnections among utility systems; and

WHEREAS, the cost to develop a Water Project will vary based on the specifics of a particular project with the capital and operating costs of AWS projects significantly higher than those of traditional groundwater source projects; and

WHEREAS, Water Projects creating utility systems interconnections will lower capital and operating costs for those systems by maximizing use of existing permitted groundwater resources; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to provide a dedicated funding source to pay the costs to develop and construct various Water Projects, to include AWS projects and interconnections between cooperating utility systems; and

WHEREAS, the County's utility rate consultant has determined that establishing a surcharge of \$0.30 per thousand gallons of potable water use will produce \$1.3 million annually in additional revenues, an amount sufficient to fund currently proposed Water Projects, to include the AWS projects and utility system interconnection initiatives identified in the County's Community Investment Program budget for the next four years, and to provide a revenue stream capable of funding \$20 million of similar debt-funded projects; and

WHEREAS, the County also desires to regionalize its water production facilities where practical so it may more cost-effectively meet current and future drinking water standards and regulations, and to incrementally increase reinvestment in its utility systems over the next four (4) years by repairing, replacing, rehabilitating, and upgrading aging and outdated system components; and

WHEREAS, the County must obtain financing through the issuance of bonds to pay for capital improvements associated with its water production facilities regionalization and utilities system reinvestment plan; and

WHEREAS, to obtain favorable bond ratings and terms, the County must maintain a debt coverage ratio of 1.5; and

WHEREAS, to maintain the necessary debt coverage ratio, the County must index water rates at two and one-half percent (2.5%) for three consecutive years beginning October 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Board has conducted a properly noticed Public Hearing in which the public was given an opportunity to be heard as to the implementation of the proposed potable water use surcharge and the two and one-half percent (2.5%) indexed water rates;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Polk County Board of County Commissioners in regular session duly assembled on August 16, 2016, as follows:

- 1. There is hereby established the Polk Water Resource Initiatives/Alternative Water Supply Surcharge (PWRI/AWS Surcharge) set at \$0.30 per thousand gallons of potable water use by all potable water customers which shall become effective on all potable water used on and after October 1, 2016. The PWRI/AWS Surcharge shall appear as a separate charge on all customer bills effective October 1, 2016. The amounts collected from the PWRI/AWS Surcharge shall be deposited into a separate fund and used only to pay Water Project costs.
- 2. All potable water rates shall be indexed (increased) two and one-half percent (2.5%) for each of the next three (3) years commencing and effective on October 1st of each year (i.e., October 1, 2017, October 1, 2018 and October 1, 2019) to pay for costs associated with the County's water production facilities regionalization initiatives and with its utilities system reinvestment plans.
- The full and complete list of all County water utilities rates, fees and charges effective upon adoption of this Resolution are set forth and stated on the tables attached as a composite Exhibit "A" to this Resolution.

COMMERCIAL CONNECTION FEES

Water Connection Fees

Commercial Water Connection fees will be assessed on projected daily usage, in accordance with the Polk County Utilities Code, divided by 360 gallons to calculate the Equivalent Residential Connection (ERC). This ERC will be multiplied by the connection fee assessed for a single Family Detached Unit on lots one acre or less.

Wastewater Connection Fees

Commercial Wastewater Connection fees will be assessed on projected daily usage, in accordance with the Polk County Utilities Code, divided by 270 gallons to calculate the Equivalent Residential Connection (ERC). This ERC will be multiplied by the connection fee assessed for a single Family Detached Unit on lots one acre or less.
