PETITION FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF NXX-X CODE DENIAL

Teleport Communications America, LLC - FL (TCAL) pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(iv), Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Order FCC 00-104, and Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Order No. PSC-01-1873-PCO-TL, petitions the Commission to review the Pooling Administrator's ("Somos") denial of TCAL's request for additional numbering resources in the Sebring rate center. In support of this petition, TCAL states:

PARTIES

- TCAL is a corporation organized and formed under the laws of the State of New Jersey.
- Somos is an independent non-governmental entity, which is responsible for administering and managing the numbering resources in pooling areas. <u>See</u> 47 C.F.R. § 52.20(d).

JURISDICTION

3. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Industry Numbering Committees (INC) Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c). This provision provides that a carrier may challenge Somos's decision to deny numbering resources to the appropriate regulatory authority.

BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF

- 4. The Sebring rate center is served by the FTMYFLXAX1Z switch where 863-451-4 and 863-593-6 has 950 and 475 numbers available respectively.
- 5. On October 28, 2019 TCAL requested 2500 consecutive numbers from Somos, for the Sebring rate center, to satisfy the customer's request.

- 6. At the time of the request, the Sebring rate center had a month-to-exhaust (MTE) of 5.27 months and utilization of 22.55%.
- 7. October 28, 2019, Somos denied TCAL's request because TCAL had not met the utilization threshold, notwithstanding the fact that TCAL is unable to provide the numbering resources requested by the specific customer. See <u>Attachment 1</u>. Pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, attached to this Petition is the customer contact information. See <u>Attachment 2</u>.
- 8. As discussed above, both the FCC Order and the INC guidelines provide that state regulatory authorities have the power and authority to review Somos's decision to deny a request for numbering resources. See INC Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c).
- 9. Under earlier MTE procedures used by NANPA, waivers or exceptions were granted when customer hardships could be demonstrated or when the service provider's inventory did not have the specific number format to meet the customer's specific request. The current process is arbitrary and results in (1) decisions contrary to the public interest and welfare of consumers in Florida; and (2) decisions that do not necessarily promote the efficient use of telephone numbers.
- 10. TCAL requests that the Commission reverse Somos's decision to withhold numbering resources on the following grounds:
 - (a) Somos's denial of numbering resources to TCAL interferes with TCAL's ability to serve its customer in Florida.
 - (b) As a result of Somos's denial of the request for additional numbering resources, TCAL is unable to provide telecommunications services to its customer as required under Florida law.

WHEREFORE, TCAL requests:

- 1. The Commission review the decision of Somos to deny TCAL's request for additional numbering resources for the Sebring rate center; and
- 2. The Commission direct Somos (Pooling Administrator effective 1/1/19) to provide the requested numbering resources for the Sebring rate center as discussed above.

<u>Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:</u>

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia Technologies, Inc. dba iconectiv (iconectivTM) LERGTM Routing Guide^{xi}. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN of its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric NECA-assigned Company Code or a four-character alphanumeric identifier assigned by the iconectivTM Telecom Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. The Switch Identification. Explanations of these terms may be found in the footnotes.

- Section 1.3 The date the Service Provider completes the application should be entered in this section, as well as the Effective Date of the requested thousands-block.
- Section 1.4 Service Providers should indicate their type, e.g., local exchange carrier, competitive local exchange carrier, interexchange carrier, CMRS or VoIP. provider is exiting the market or is exchanging a block that was identified as being over 10% contaminated. If the block being returned is over 10% contaminated, the PA shall seek a new block holder. If question c and/or d have a response of No, the request for return shall be denied.


