Mr. Hampson and Mr. Coston,

Below you will find Florida Public Utilities' responses to your additional questions (from our call on Friday).

- 1. *Is FPUC currently receiving/using compressed natural gas?* FPUC is currently using CNG from trailers at different locations for differing reasons (which could include the stabilization of local pipeline pressure).
- 2. What standards are we currently using for non-pipeline gas? The gas quality standards for all CNG deliveries meets "pipeline quality" and the CNG provider obtains gas quality measurements of the gas being delivered to the CNG trailers. Gas quality is typically measured by using a gas chromatograph, which provides real time gas quality measurements.
- 3. *Is there a difference between heat content and heating value?* Heat content and heating value are the same.
- 4. **Finally, they would like us to forward the quality standard references that we mentioned in our responses.** Below are two links which are representative of the information that
