To whom it may concern,

As a newly formed entity, NextCity Networks, LLC ("NCN") does not have audited financial statements for the most recent three years as requested by the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Application for Original Authority to Provide Telecommunications Service ("Application"), as well as Florida Statute § 364.335(a)(5). However, NCN will have adequate access to capital through its indirect parent company, NextEra Energy, Inc. ("NextEra"), to fund NCN's telecommunications business objectives. Consequently, based on advice received from Commission staff, in lieu of the materials identified in Section 9(c) of the Application form, NCN is demonstrating its financial ability via the financial statements of its parent company.
