RE:	Docket No. 20200089-TA - Petition for expedited review of NXX-X code denial by Number Pooling Administrator for the Orlando rate center, by BellSouth Telecommunications LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida.

On January 30, 2020, BellSouth Telecommunications LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (Somos) for the Orlando rate center, ORLDFLMADS1 switch. AT&T Florida requested two blocks to meet the request of a specific customer for 2,000 consecutive numbers. On January 30, 2020, AT&T Florida's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the utilization criteria.

On Thursday, March 12, 2020, AT&T Florida filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn Somos' decision. In accordance with Section 2.07C.5.d(2). of the Administrative Procedures Manual (APM), staff has examined AT&T Florida's petition and has determined the following:

- The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
- The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to these potential customers because of Somos' denial of the numbering resources; and
- Customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of Section 2.07C.5.d(2). of the APM have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (April 1, 2020), as outlined in the APM expedited code denial process. Somos should be directed to provide AT&T Florida the numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Orlando rate center, ORLDFLMADS1 switch.
