1 PROCEEDINGS 2 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Okay. We will call this 3 meeting to order. 4 It's Tuesday, June the 9th. This is the 5 prehearing conference for Docket No. 20200107-EM. 6 Staff, if I can get you to read the notice, 7 please. 8 MR. MURPHY: By notices issued on April 30th 9 and May 1st, 2020, this time and place has been set 10 for a prehearing conference in Docket No. 11 20200107-EM. The purpose of the prehearing is set 12 out more fully in the notices. COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Let's take appearances. 13 14 MR. WRIGHT: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Robert 15 Scheffel Wright, Gardner Law Firm, on behalf of 16 Orlando Utilities Commission. I would like also to 17 enter appearances for my law partner John T. Lavia, 18 III, and for W. Christopher Browder, the General 19 Counsel of OUC. 20 Thank you. 21 This is Charlie Murphy and MR. MURPHY: 22 Gabriella Passidomo for Commission staff. 23 MS. HELTON: And, Mr. Chairman, Mary Anne 24 Helton is here as your advisor, along with your 25 General Counsel, Keith Hetrick.

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COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Okay. Mr. Murphy,
preliminary matters.

MR. MURPHY: Staff notes that -- that State buildings are currently closed to the public due to the COVID-19. Accordingly, the hearing in this docket will be conducted remotely, and all parties, witnesses and members of the public will present argument and testimony by communications media technology.

10 Members of the public who only want to observe 11 or listen to the hearing may do so via the live 12 video broadcast, which will be available on the 13 Commission website. Upon completion of the 14 hearing, the archived video will also be available. 15 Staff is not aware of any other preliminary 16 matters.

17 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Does anybody else have18 any preliminary matters?

19MR. WRIGHT: We are good, Mr. Chairman. Thank20you.

21 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Okay. Let's go through 22 the draft prehearing order now. We will go through 23 section by section, so when I call a specific 24 sections, if you have something to change or add or 25 comment on, please speak up.

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1 That being said, let's start with Section I. 2 Okay, Section II. 3 Okay, Section III. Section IV. 4 5 Section V. Section VI. 6 7 Section VII. Section VIII. 8 9 Section IX. 10 Commissioner, staff has prepared MR. MURPHY: 11 and circulated a draft comprehensive exhibit list 12 which includes all prefiled exhibits and staff's 13 With the understanding that the list exhibits. 14 will need to be modified to accurately describe the 15 inclusion of an attachment to the company's 16 petition in this docket, OUC does not object to the 17 comprehensive exhibit list. Staff will wait to determine if there will be 18 19 any public exhibits prior to finalizing the 20 comprehensive exhibit list and prehearing order. 21 Public exhibits are due by close of business 22 today. 23 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Any other comments on 24 Section IX? 25 Okay, Section X.

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1 Commissioner, subject to the MR. MURPHY: 2 edits described before, staff and OUC have 3 stipulated the entry into the record of all exhibits identified in the comprehensive exhibit 4 5 list thus far. Any additional public exhibits will be circulated and reviewed to determine if they can 6 7 be stipulated. 8 MR. WRIGHT: Mr. -- Mr. Chairman, Schef Wright 9 here. 10 I would also note that given that there is no 11 adverse participation in this proceeding by any 12 party, OUC is ready, willing and able to work with 13 staff toward stipulations of substantive issues and 14 will do so. 15 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Thank you, Mr. Wright. 16 Okay, any other comments on Section X? 17 Section XI. 18 By tomorrow, staff will have an MR. MURPHY: 19 order for the prehearing officer's review 20 addressing OUC's motion for corrective order. 21 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Section XII. 22 Similarly, by tomorrow, staff MR. MURPHY: 23 will have an order for the prehearing officer's 24 review addressing OUC's pending request for 25 confidential classification.

1 UNIDENDIFIED SPEAKER: (Inaudible) 2 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Is there somebody trying 3 to comment on Section XII? 4 UNIDENDIFIED SPEAKER: Hey. 5 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Okay, I can't hear whoever it is. 6 7 Section XIII. 8 MR. MURPHY: There are no conflicts with the 9 order establishing procedure. 10 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Section XIV. 11 MR. MURPHY: If the Commission makes a bench 12 decision in this matter, there will be no need for 13 post-hearing briefs. If briefs are required, they 14 will be due May 23rd, 2020, and should not exceed 15 40 pages. 16 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Mr. Wright, is that okay 17 with you? 18 Yes, sir. MR. WRIGHT: 19 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Okay. Section XV, 20 opening statements. 21 Opening statements will be limited to three 22 minutes unless -- unless decides to waive opening 23 I think -statements. 24 MR. WRIGHT: I think --25 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: I'm sorry?

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1 I hope when we get there next MR. WRIGHT: 2 Thursday that we are in a position to waive the 3 opening statements, Mr. Chairman. 4 Thank you. 5 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Okay. Witness summaries are limited to three minutes, and public testimony 6 7 will be five minutes. And that's because the 8 Chairman wishes it that way. 9 Okay. Other matters? 10 MR. MURPHY: No other matters to address. 11 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Mr. Wright, did you have 12 anything else? 13 No, sir. MR. WRIGHT: Thank you. 14 Then, Mr. Murphy, as far COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: 15 as I can see it, then we are ready to adjourn? 16 MR. MURPHY: Yes, sir. Thank you. 17 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Okay.
