JOINT REPORT OF PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM AND THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF CHESAPEAKE UTILITIES CORPORATION ON STATUS OF TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT

In Order No. PSC-07-0944-PAA-GU, issued on November 28, 2007, in Docket No. 070399-GU, the Commission approved the amended and restated territorial agreement between Peoples Gas System, a division of Tampa Electric Company ("PGS"), and the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation ("CUC") (the "Agreement"), the provisions of which are governed by the master territorial agreement between the parties ("Master Agreement"), which was approved by that same Commission Order. Section 3 "H" of the Master Agreement calls for a meeting of the parties prior to the second anniversary of the effective date of the Agreement (and no more than every fifth anniversary thereafter), with a joint report on the status of the Agreement to be submitted to the Commission following such meetings.

By this report, PGS and CUC advise the Commission that (i) the Agreement remains in full force and effect, (ii) no modifications are currently proposed in the terms of the Agreement, and (iii) since the most recent status report on the Agreement filed with the Commission, no disputes between the parties have arisen concerning the provisions of the Agreement.

The parties will advise the Commission to the extent that any changes to the Agreement are proposed, and will petition the Commission to resolve any disputes which may arise with respect to the provisions of the Agreement if the parties are

unable to resolve the same.
