Per the Statute, proprietary confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Subsection (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

The information provided in Exhibit MDW-1 for which confidential treatment is being sought can be described as major equipment cost, such as solar panels and transformers, and balance of system cost, such as racking, post inverters, and EPC cost. Staff has reviewed the information TECO filed in Exhibit MDW-1. It is staff's opinion that the information that is the subject of this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S. and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
