Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C), Gulf Power Company (Gulf') requests confidential classification of certain information provided in response to the staff's First Request for Production of Documents (POD) No. 1. Gulf requested confidentiality under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S., information relating to competitive interests. The Utility's response to this POD contains invoices with information regarding the pricing for services performed by a third party vendor. Disclosure of this information would place the third party vendor at a competitive disadvantage when bidding on similar future projects.

Staff has reviewed the invoices within the Utility's response to POD No. 1. The invoices from the third party vendor are for the Plant Scholz and Plant Smith ash-pond closure projects. Staff recommends that the information provided be classified as confidential pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
