If you are going to do this, I ask that your reconsider the time frame given on page 5 starting with line 9 and in line 10 change the "within 6 months" to at least 12 months. The reason why is that some folks come to Florida for 2 or 3 months of the year and sometimes they skip a season. My concern with the 6 month time frame also revolves around the time frames. If a customer only comes for one month, my staff has to go back and calculate and try and figure out when that 6 month timeline was. Its easier to calculate a year time frame.
