Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Peoples Gas System (PGS or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information filed to supplement a response to staff discovery dated August 18, 2020. This recommendation specifically addresses PGS's supplemental response to Staff's 1st Set of Interrogatories (ROG), No. 1.

Staff has reviewed the supplemental response information PGS filed in response to Staff's 1^{st} ROG, No. 1 as well as the Company's confidentiality request. It is staff's opinion that the information that is the subject of this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S.
