To Whom It May Concern - Dear Commissioners,

I am writing this as a very concerned citizen. In my opinion, all the facts have not been honestly presented to the Commission by Utilities, Inc.

Therefore, I am enclosing my last water bill statements with notations of my concerns. I own a triplex <u>building</u> with 3 units. But, unit#3 has been vacant since April 28, 2020. I had the water turned on in my name, so I could clean, paint, repair, update, etc. It took me 2 months, but even if I used much less water the bill was always \$103.68 (each unit is separately metered). My last bill for this unit the water usage was 0.0, yet the bill was still \$103.68. As a comparison, my power bill for this unit was less if I used less power each month!

Also, I want to call your attention to the charge for the Recycleable — Containers. They brought 3 containers but one was sufficient (and has been over the years) that's all I took. However, I was told each unit would have to pay for one monthly either way! Yes, they do charge each tenant monthly. I have 3 Solid Waste and 1 Recycleable Container.

In conclusion, these factors are invisible rate hikes already! Charts, grafts, figures, etc. can be designed to reflect information in different manners (rename items and put them in a different spot and they become a liability).

Thank you for taking the time to read this, I don't expect any response, but I felt a need to express my feelings. I too am hurting from the pandemic, but there has been NO stimulus check or relief in sight for me!!



### NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

Pursuant to Section 367.081 (4) (a), Florida Statutes, water and wastewater utilities are permitted to adjust the rates it charges to its customers without those customers bearing the additional expense of a public hearing. These adjustments in rates would depend on increases or decreases in non-controllable expenses subject to inflationary pressures such as chemicals and other general operation and maintenance costs.

On April 1, 2020 Utilities Inc. of Florida filed its notice of intention with the Florida Public Service Commission to increase water and wastewater rates in Charlotte, Highlands, Lake, Lee, Marion, Orange, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, and Seminole Counties pursuant to this Statute. The filing is subject to review by the Commission Staff for accuracy and completeness. If approved by the Commission, water rates will increase by 0.86% and wastewater rates will increase by 0.68%. Additionally, Miscellaneous Service Charges will increase by 0.76%. These rates should be reflected on your bills for service rendered on or after May 31, 2020.


