- 2. Peoples hereby seeks confidential treatment with regard to the above referenced documents which is described more fully in Exhibit A.
- 3. The documents contain confidential proprietary business information primarily in the form of details concerning capital projects the disclosure of which would impair Peoples competitive business operations.
- 4. The material for which confidential classification is sought is intended to be and is treated as private by Peoples and has not been otherwise disclosed.

The time period requested is necessary to protect the competitive information regarding Peoples current and future capital projects which includes Peoples future expansion plans. The period of time requested will ultimately protect Peoples and its customers.
