PETITION FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF NXX-X CODE DENIAL

Bell South Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T") pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(iv), Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Order FCC 00-104, and Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Order No. PSC-01-1873-PCO-TL, petitions the Commission to review the Pooling Administrator's ("Somos") denial of AT&T's request for additional numbering resources in the Hollywood rate center. In support of this petition, AT&T states:

PARTIES

- 1. AT&T is a corporation organized and formed under the laws of the State of Georgia.
- 2. Somos is an independent non-governmental entity, which is responsible for administering and managing the numbering resources in pooling areas. <u>See</u> 47 C.F.R. § 52.20(d).

JURISDICTION

3. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Industry Numbering Committees (INC) Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c). This provision provides that a carrier may challenge Somos's decision to deny numbering resources to the appropriate regulatory authority.

BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF

- 4. The Hollywood rate center is served by only 1 switch (HLWDFLPEDSO). The month to -exhaust is 1714.14 months and utilization is 28.07%
- 5. On August 20, 2020, AT&T requested 750 consecutive numbers, in a format that integrates into their existing 6-digit dial plan AND does not conflict with the following:

18-XXXX	65-XXXX
2X-XXXX	67-XXXX
38-XXXX	75-XXXX
41-XXXX	76-XXXX
44-XXXX	82-XXXX
5X-XXXX	83-XXXX

6. At the time of the request, the Hollywood rate center had a month-to-exhaust (MTE) of 1714.14 months and utilization is 28.07%.

- 7. On August 20, 2020. Somos denied AT&T's request because AT&T had not met the MTE or utilization thresholds, notwithstanding the fact that AT&T is unable to provide the numbering resources requested by the specific customer. See attached Customer Letter of Intent and supporting blocks to avoid.
- 8. As discussed above, both the FCC Order and the INC guidelines provide that state regulatory authorities have the power and authority to review Somos's decision to deny a request for numbering resources. See INC Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c).
- 9. Under earlier MTE procedures used by NANPA, waivers or exceptions were granted when customer hardships could be demonstrated or when the service provider's inventory did not have the specific number format to meet the customer's specific request. The current process is arbitrary and results in (1) decisions contrary to the public interest and welfare of consumers in Florida; and (2) decisions that do not necessarily promote the efficient use of telephone numbers.
- 10. AT&T requests that the Commission's reverse Somos's decision to withhold numbering resources on the following grounds:
 - (a) Somos's denial of numbering resources to AT&T interferes with AT&T's ability to serve its customer in Florida.
 - (b) As a result of Somos's denial of the request for additional numbering resources, AT&T is unable to provide telecommunications services to its customer as required under Florida law.

WHEREFORE, AT&T requests:

- The Commission review the decision of Somos to deny AT&T's request for additional numbering resources for the Hollywood rate center; and
- The Commission direct Somos to provide the requested numbering resources for the Hollywood rate center as discussed above.





Instructions for filling out each Section of the Part 1A form:

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers (SP) supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator (PA) section also requires the SP to fill in the PA's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers (SP) who need a Thousands-Block (NPA-NXX-X) assignment or for a Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a Part 1 Central Office Code (NPA-NXX) Application needs to also be submitted to the Pooling Administrator (PA). The SP should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA); the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the Telcordia Technologies, Inc. dba iconectiv (iconectiv®) LERGTM Routing Guide^{Xi}. If the Thousands-Block being returned is over 10% contaminated, the Pooling Administrator (PA) shall seek a new Thousands-Block Holder. If question c and/or d have a response of No, the request for return shall be denied.




