Re: Lee County Electric Cooperative ("LCEC") Modifications to Rate Schedules Pertaining To LED Street Lighting

Enclosed for filing and administrative approval by Commission staff are the following LCEC rate schedules:

- Rate Schedule SL-2 First Revised Sheet No. 17.100 Canceling Original Sheet No. 17.100.
- Rate Schedule OL-2 First Revised Sheet No. 18.000 Canceling Original Sheet No. 18.000
- Rate Schedule OL-2 First Revised Sheet No. 18.100 Canceling Original Sheet No. 18.100.
- Rate Schedule DL-1 Original Sheets Nos. 18.400–18.600

Purpose of Filing

As part of LCEC's ongoing efforts to offer energy efficient light emitting diode ("LED") lighting service to its members, on October 15, 2020, LCEC's Board of Trustees approved modifications to the existing rate schedules OL-2 Private Area Lighting Electric Service and SL-2 Public Street and Highway Lighting Electric Service. The modifications would close those portions of the referenced rate schedules regarding "decorative fixtures" to new installations on the effective date of the modification. Thereafter, new installations would receive service under LCEC's new rate schedule DL-1 Decorative Lighting Electric Service, which LCEC's Board of Trustees also approved on October 15, 2020.

LCEC's Board of Trustees created the new DL-1 rate schedule for three primary reasons: (i) member demand, (ii) LED street lights are more energy efficient, and (iii) manufacturers are starting to phase out the production of HPS lights for LED lights.

Effective Date

The modified rate schedules described above do not present new pricing concepts; instead they are simply another step in LCEC's ongoing efforts to offer energy efficient LED lighting service to its members. LCEC believes that all of the modifications discussed above are fair, just and reasonable, and should be administratively approved by staff. The tariff changes shall be effective January 1, 2021.
