BACKGROUND

Utilities Inc., of Florida (the "Utility") is a water and wastewater utility whose corporate offices are located at 200 Weathersfield Avenue, Altamonte Springs, Florida. The Utility's water and wastewater facilities are located in Charlotte, Highlands, Lake, Lee, Marion, Orange, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, and Seminole Counties, Florida.

On June 30, 2020, the Utility filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for an increase in its water and wastewater rates to its customers based on an historical test year ending December 31, 2019. Final rates and interim rates are based upon the same test year. The application is assigned Docket No. 20200139-WS and August 31, 2020, was established as the official date of filing.

The Utility is requesting a rate increase because the existing rates do not provide sufficient revenues to cover the required expenses of operations on a going-forward basis and a fair return on the Utility's investment in used and useful property for the public use, including pro forma projects. The rate of return on equity requested in this proceeding on a system-wide basis is 11.75%. The overall return requested (the weighted cost of debt and equity) is 7.889%. According to the Utility's books, Utilities, Inc. of Florida states that its current overall rate of return without a rate increase is 4.22% for its water systems and 2.56% for its wastewater systems. The Company's last rate proceeding was in Docket No. 20160101-WS utilizing a historic December 31, 2015, test year. That proceeding culminated in Order No. PSC-2017-0361-FOF-WS, issued September 25, 2017, as amended by Order No. PSC-2017-0361A-FOF-WS issued October 4, 2017. On remand from the First District Court of Appeal, Order No. PSC-2019-0363-PAA-WS was issued on August 27, 2019.

The Utility has requested a permanent revenue increase for its water and wastewater systems of \$2,812,445, or 16.94% for its water system, and \$6,521,686, or 32.12% increase for its wastewater system. The requested increase would produce annual revenues of \$19,416,373 for its water system and \$26,827,568 for its wastewater system.
