Yes, Commissioner. 6 MS. PASSIDOMO: All issues 7 have been stipulated in this docket, and the 8 parties have agreed to excuse all witnesses and to include all exhibits on the comprehensive exhibit 9 10 list in the record. 11 COMMISSIONER FAY: Great. Any other party 12 have any other preliminary matters? 13 With that, we'll begin moving through the 14 draft prehearing order. Similar to 02 and 03, 15 please feel free to speak up if there's an issue 16 you want to address under the case background, 17 conduct of proceedings, and jurisdiction.
