On October 16, 2020 Peoples Gas System (PGS) filed a request for confidential treatment for Document No. 09544-2020. This document consists of supplemental documents in response to OPC's First Request for Production of Documents (No. 39). PGS has requested confidentiality for highlighted portions of documents BS 12674-12683. The information which PGS seeks confidential treatment is a presentation to the Board of Directors regarding a specific capital project. This document contains information regarding project timelines, regulatory considerations, the project's financial summary, and the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding.

In its request for confidentiality, PGS asserts that disclosure of this information would cause harm to Peoples and its customers as the information relates to competitive interests. PGS asserts that disclosure of such information would impair the efforts of the public utility to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. Furthermore, PGS maintains that the information provided in Document No. 11332-2020 has not been publicly disclosed.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with PGS that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair the competitive business operations of PGS. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by PGS for confidential classification of Document No. 11332-2020 be approved.
