Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information in the direct testimony and exhibits of OPC's witness, Hulmuth Schultz III.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its information under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S., and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
