To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to you to ask you to **reject** the application by Environmental Utilities, LLC (EU) to install sewers in the Cape Haze subdivision in Charlotte County.

As the owner of 3 properties in this area, I'm greatly disturbed that this project would even be considered.

EU is a start up company without the requisite experience to manage the projected sewer system construction and subsequent operation.

They have not demonstrated, to the affected areas, that they have the necessary financial wherewithal to build out this system and then manage it on an ongoing basis.

Further, they have no firm idea as to the cost of the system or the costs to the individual homeowners. No provision is being made to allow those residents who would be hurt financially to make payments over time. Nor is there any information available to us about any grants to defray the costs to us.

Cape Haze is in the Charlotte County Utilities (CCU) service area and as such if sewers are to be installed they should be done under the auspices of CCU.

However, we dispute the generalized findings in the 2017 Charlotte County Sewer study as to the need to remove our septic tanks and replace them with sewers.
