To Whom It May Concern,

My name is John Jenack I am writing to you as a property owner on Don Pedro Island [141 Kettle Harbor Drive], which is within the service area contained in the application from Environmental Utilities, LLC [EU] for central sewer.

Specifically, I am writing to **OBJECT to EU's request for the bifurcation of the certificate and rate-making proceedings and I OBJECT to the granting of a temporary waiver of Rule 25-30.033(1)(p) and (q)**. Given the inadequate information regarding the applicant's financial strength and management and oversight experience, as well as the costs to the stakeholders involved with this project, **the applicant's request for a waiver should be DENIED.**

As a stakeholder in the proposed service area, I believe it is important to have all of the relevant information regarding the proposed central sewer, including the proposed rates, connection fees and the type of system intended for installation. Without them, it is impossible for residents/stakeholders to make an informed decision, both individually and on the general community's behalf. **I therefore request that EU's request for bifurcation and a temporary waiver be DENIED.**
