Ms. Mills,

Thank you for your comments regarding the rate increase petition filed by Sunny Shores Utilities, LLC (Sunny Shores or Utility). Sunny Shores was acquired by the current owner on July 27, 2020. Part of the reason for the petition for an increase, is to make necessary improvements to the system. Your concerns regarding the low water pressure have been presented to our engineering division so that they may look further into the issue. Staff is also looking into your concerns regarding the shut-off notices that were sent out. Your comments along with this response will be placed in the docket file for the parties to view.

The rates presented in the staff report issued April 19, 2021, are preliminary in nature and may be different from the rates included in staff's recommendation to the Commission, currently scheduled to be filed on July 22, 2021. Further, the Commission is not bound by staff's recommendation, so again, the rates that are ultimately approved may differ from those contained in the preliminary staff report, or in staff's recommendation. The Commission's final vote is tentatively scheduled for the August 3, 2021 Commission Conference.

I appreciate your comments, and understand your concerns regarding staff's preliminary rate calculation and low water pressure.
