Dear Commissioner

Please take a harder look at the FPL settlement, which in its current form will allow FPL to avoid going on the record with answers to questions about its clean energy goals and its commitment to keeping its rates affordable.

We invested in solar for our home earlier this year. We have consistently generated more energy that we draw from FPL--yet we are charged \$9.99 per month by FPL. My sister in Arizona, who installed solar at the same time as we did, has actually received credits--money sent to her--by her utility company. We are receiving nothing from FPL but still being charged.

It is time to stop enriching someone at the expense of consumers. FPL needs to be forced to harden its systems to storm resistance--including widespread undergrounding of lines--and commit to clean energy goals. I have no doubt they can accomplish this at current rates to residential customers.
