To Whom It May Concern:

I was recently reviewing TECO's rate increase application and did not find anything relating to a revision of its Schedule 8, incorporating the COG-1 rate.

I am writing a news article about the economics of solar power generation and would appreciate any commentary or feedback from the Florida Public Service Commission regarding any (1) public comments submitted on the rates that TECO will pay net producers under the COG-1 rate schedule, (2) voluntary updates to that portion of the tariff, or (3) any concerns expressed by the PSC regarding that rate.

The COG-1 is especially germane to TECO's recent rate request where consumers are being asked to pay higher rates to pay for solar power infrastructure. It seems the PSC and TECO should likewise revisit the COG-1 to determine whether it reflects TECO's changing energy mix, and if not considered, then an explanation for why. Thank you.
