CITIZENS' PETITION FOR A HEARING ON PROPOSED RULE 25-30.445

Pursuant to section 120.54(3)(c), Florida Statutes (2021), the Citizens of the State of Florida ("Citizens"), through the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") file this request for a hearing on proposed rule 25-30.445, Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."), as contained in the Order PSC-2021-0391-NOR-WS, issued on October 14, 2021. In support of this request, the Citizens state as follows:

- On October 12, 2021, at its regularly scheduled agenda meeting, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") considered and adopted the above-styled proposed rules after hearing comments from its Staff, OPC, and a utility.
- 2. During this consideration, OPC asked the Commission to deny a change to section (6)(a) of proposed rule 25-30.445, F.A.C., or, alternatively, to limit the scope of the change.
- 3. The Commission denied OPC's request and adopted the proposed rule.
- 4. On October 14, 2021, the Commission issued its Notice of Proposed Rule in accordance with section 120.54(3)(a), Florida Statutes (2021).
- 5. Citizens object to proposed rule 25-30.445, F.A.C., and request a public hearing in order to provide evidence and argument on this issue so that the Commission can consider revising the proposed rule.
- 6. Citizens propose that the Commission substitute the language in section 6(a) with the proposed language in Attachment A.

Public Counsel's Suggested Change to Proposed Rule 25-30.445(6)(a):

- (6) A limited proceeding will not be allowed if: In evaluating whether the utility's request is improper for a limited proceeding, the Commission will consider factors such as:
- (a) Whether Tthe utility's filing includes more than 4 separate projects for which recovery is sought unless the utility is eligible for staff-assistance pursuant to Section 367.0814, Fla. Stat.

 Utilities eligible for staff assistance pursuant to Section 367.0814, Fla. Stat. shall be limited to 6 separate projects under this section. and the requested rate increase exceeds 30 percent.

 Corresponding adjustments for a given project are not subject to the above limitation;
