2	CHAIRMAN FAY: Commissioners, next we will
3	take up Items 5, 6 and 7 together. They are all
4	standard offer contract items for three separate
5	utilities.
6	With that, Mr. Phillips, I allow to you
7	present these items. Thank you.
8	MR. PHILLIPS: Donald Phillips with Commission
9	staff.
10	Items No. 5, 6 and 7 are the petitions for
11	approval of the 2022 amended standard offer
12	contracts by Tampa Electric Company, Duke Energy
13	Florida and Florida Power & Light respectively.
14	Florida Statutes require that each
15	investor-owned utility continuously offer standard
16	offer contracts to purchase capacity and energy
17	from renewable energy generators in small
18	qualifying facilities. The Commission's rules base
19	this contracts provisions on the next avoidable
20	fossil-fueled generating unit identified in the
21	utility's 10-year site plan.
22	Staff has reviewed the filings and believes
23	they are consistent with the next avoidable unit
24	for each utility. Staff recommends approval of the
25	revised standard offer contracts and associated

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1 rate schedules.

2 No comments were filed in these dockets. 3 Staff is available for any questions you may have. 4 CHAIRMAN FAY: Great. Thank you, Mr. 5 Phillips. And thank you for your briefing on this. Commissioners, I just have one comment on this 6 7 and I will be happy to entertain a motion after 8 that. 9 I know there is a lot of discussion about fuel 10 cost and diversity of energy portfolios. I know 11 this is one method to potentially create that

12 diversity from other generators, and I think, in 13 the future, we just probably need to consider the 14 changes in renewables, potential batteries, fuel, 15 other variables that go into these. And, you know, 16 I am going to approve the items today as presented 17 and the recommendation, but I think in the future 18 we just might need to give some greater 19 consideration to changes in energy. 20 So with that, I will take a motion. 21 Mr. Chairman, I move all COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: 22 issues on -- excuse me, I move staff recommendation 23 on all issues on Items 5, 6 and 7. 24 We have a motion. CHAIRMAN FAY: Do we have a 25 second?
