Pursuant to Order No. PSC-2022-0120-PAA-WU (Order), issued March 18, 2022, CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR or Utility) was required 1) to notify the Commission in writing that its books have been adjusted in accordance with the Commission's decision; and 2) submit the executed and recorded warranty deed and copies of its application for permit transfer to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and Saint Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD) within 60 days of the Order. The Order also advised that this docket shall be closed administratively in the event the Order becomes final and the aforementioned actions are completed.

The Order became final pursuant to Order No. PSC-2022-0136-CO-WU, issued on April 11, 2022. On May 25, 2022, CSWR provided a copy of the executed and recorded warranty deed for the land upon which its facilities are located. On June 6, 2022, the Utility provided copies of its applications to the SJRWMD for the permit transfer. Additionally, no copies of its application for permit transfer needed to be submitted to the DEP, as this Utility provides water service only. On July 11, 2022, CSWR notified the Commission in writing that its books have been updated to reflect the Commission-required accounting adjustments. Staff has determined that the Utility has demonstrated compliance with Order No. PSC-2022-0120-PAA-WU, and requests that this docket be closed administratively.
