AT&T Wisconsin (collectively referred to herein as “AT&T”), applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended (“the Act”), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission”) rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue AT&T Operator Services and AT&T Directory Assistance for AT&T Phonesm (formerly U-verse[®] Voice) customers throughout its service area in Alabama, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Wisconsin.

Date of Planned Service Discontinuance:

Effective on or after January 1, 2023, pending regulatory approval, AT&T Operator Services and AT&T Directory Assistance for AT&T Phone (the “Affected Services”) will no longer be available to new customers or existing customers. The discontinuance of the Affected Services will only apply to AT&T Phone service, which is a Voice over Internet

Protocol service provided to consumers and small businesses. AT&T's traditional wireline voice service, AT&T Residential Local Service (*i.e.*, "POTS"), is unaffected by this discontinuance.

Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

AT&T will no longer offer the Affected Services through its service territory in Alabama, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Kansas, Louisiana, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, Nevada, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Wisconsin.

Brief Description of Type of Service Affected:

AT&T Operator Services allows callers to obtain various types of assistance from operators, including placing domestic or international calls, transferring and connecting callers to emergency services providers or other public service agencies, and providing general assistance information to customers such as area codes, city codes, dialing instructions, and time of day.

AT&T Directory Assistance allows callers to obtain and call the telephone number for a business or residence anywhere in the country, get a name and address associated with a telephone number they already have but may not recognize, or search for a number by type of business.

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by this discontinuance. AT&T has seen an extreme decline in the usage of both Affected Services, with AT&T Operator Services volumes across all voice products decreasing by 74% over the last 10 years, and AT&T Directory Assistance volumes across all voice products decreasing by 90% over the same period. These services have declined in popularity in part due to the growth of other communication methods, including mobile phones, text messaging, email,

and other social media applications. Moreover, AT&T Phone customers have numerous alternative technologies and services – including those available over the public internet – to replicate the functionality of the Affected Services.¹ Alternatives include, but are not limited to, Internet search engines like Google, Yahoo, or Bing; voice-activated devices like Alexa, Siri, and Google Home; speed-dial lists available on customer equipment or over-the-top services like Skype; various online and printed directories; and Telecommunications Relay Service.

In addition, as described below, AT&T is giving customers significant notice of these changes, thus allowing ample time to identify alternative methods to obtain the same information and services provided by the Affected Services.

Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers:

AT&T sent customer notifications via U.S. mail as an attachment to each customer's monthly bill between October 22, 2022 and November 21, 2022.² Customers will continue to receive the notification with their bills for an additional two bill cycles. For customers who receive their bills electronically, AT&T sent them a separate email notification, and where such emails were undeliverable, AT&T sent notifications via direct mail.³ AT&T also has posted information regarding the discontinuance at att.com/OADRetirement.

In addition, beginning on October 17, 2022 for Operator Services and on November 2, 2022 for Directory Assistance, when an AT&T customer uses one of the Affected Services, a recorded message will inform the customer of the proposed discontinuance and provide a web address and phone number where the customer can obtain additional information.⁴

Copies of this Application are being sent via first class U.S. Mail to the public utility commission, governor, federally recognized tribes (if any) in the affected states, and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.⁵

Regulatory Classification of Carrier:

The Affected Services are provided through an interconnected VoIP offering, and thus AT&T is treated as a non-dominant carrier for these services under the Commission's rules.⁶

Notice of updated terms

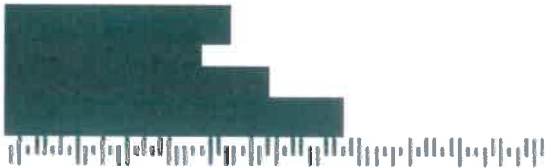
