RE: Docket No. 20220120-PU – Documents regarding FCC Proceeding 20-276.

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) opened Proceeding 20-276 to help resolve a pole attachment dispute between BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida d/b/a AT&T Southeast (TL720) (AT&T Florida) and Duke Energy Florida, LLC d/b/a Duke Energy (EI801) (Duke Energy). Before the dispute was resolved, on June 9, 2022, the Florida Public Service Commission filed a certification with the FCC that the State of Florida now regulates pole attachments pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §224(c). On June 29, 2022, the Office of Industry Development and Market Analysis opened Docket No. 20220120-PU to take receipt of documents from FCC Proceeding 20-276.

On January 5, 2023 (DN 00103-2023), AT&T Florida and Duke Energy stated that they have entered into a confidential agreement that resolves all matters related to Docket 20220120-PU and that there is no need for any Commission action in this proceeding. All confidential documents have been scheduled for destruction. There are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission. Docket No. 20220120-PU should be closed in accordance with Section 2.07.C.2.d.(4), Administrative Procedures Manual.
