MR. BUYS: Good morning, Commissioners. Item 2 is staff's recommendation in Docket No. 20220162-EI regarding Tampa Electric Company's request for approval to change the rate used to account for the allowance for funds used during construction, otherwise known as the AFUDC rate, from 5.98 percent to 6.07 percent.

I would like to clarify that although the docket title reflects an AFUDC rate change from 5.98 percent to 6.09 percent, the Commission is voting on approval of staff's recommendation to change the rate to 6.07 percent. During the review of the company's initial request, it was determined that the company did not use the most recent 13-month period to calculate the rate pursuant to the AFUDC rule. Subsequently, the company refiled its request with revised calculations. It slightly lower the requested rate from 6.09 to 6.07 percent. Staff reviewed Tampa Electric's request and confirmed the company's calculations comply with the requirements of Rule 25-6.0141 and recommends

1	approval on all issues.
